

TFAH Website Privacy Policy

Trust for America's Health (TFAH) respects the privacy of our website visitors. Our Privacy Policy explains how TFAH collects, uses and discloses personal information on www.afphs.org, via email and other digital communications under the control of TFAH. This Privacy Policy may change periodically.

Website visitors

TFAH uses Google Analytics to collect data on site visitors such as, but not limited to, how visitors navigated to afphs.org (from a new site, social media, or search engine, etc.), total site visitors, time spent on site, page views, geolocation information (state or country of residence). This data may be used for website improvement, internal analysis, program evaluation and validation. This data is reviewed at the aggregate level and for internal use only. User IP addresses are masked within the Google Analytics platform and are not accessible to TFAH.

Personal information and Email Accounts

If a user elects to sign up to subscribe to a newsletter or webinar through afphs.org, TFAH will retain information volunteered by the user in the sign-up forms. This list is a voluntary "opt-in" list, and you may remove your account at any time by sending an e-mail to info@tfah.org or by clicking "unsubscribe." We will not share or sell your email account to any group or individual at any time.

- <u>Do Not Track</u>: Your browser or device may include "Do Not Track" functionality. The information collection and disclosure practices and the choices that we provide to you will continue to operate as described in this Policy regardless of whether a Do Not Track signal is received.
- Your California Privacy Rights; "Shine the Light" Law: Once a year and free of charge, California residents are entitled to request and obtain certain information regarding our disclosure, if any, of certain categories of personal information to third parties for their own direct marketing purposes in the preceding calendar year. Cookies

Like many other websites, we use cookies, pixels, web beacons, Software Development Kits ("SDKs") and/or similar online targeting technologies (collectively, "cookies"). We may use the following types of cookies:

• First-party cookies: These are cookies that are stored on the user's device from a computer or domain managed by TFAH and from which the sites requested by the user are provided.



- Third-party cookies: These are cookies that are stored on the user's device from a computer or domain that is not managed by TFAH, but by advertising or analytics companies that processes the data obtained through the cookies.
 - To help facilitate the delivery of relevant content, we use Google Analytics. Google Analytics uses cookies to report on user interactions on our and others' sites. We use the information collected for optimizing marketing, refining advertising, and/or programming strategies, and generally improving user experience.
